God Gave His Only Son

The twentieth anniversary of the *White Dove* is coming. I cannot describe these twenty years in a word. I have spent exciting days, but if I dare to describe it in short, I would say I have never been bored even for a day. Before I encountered the Lord, without knowing the name of God I prayed, “Please give me a life which will never bore me.” And God heard such a desire of one person.

By “not to be bored” I meant that I wished to have a kind of life where I could not predict what would happen next and my heart would be always filled with increasing expectation and excitement. The encounter with the Lord, however, gave me far more than what I had wished.

Today (one week before the memorial day of the *White Dove*) I prayed and asked the Lord to give me the most suitable scripture to describe the past twenty years. I expected that He would respond to me with the verse from Galatians, which I had cherished from the beginning of my spiritual journey:

It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me; and the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

(Galatians 2:20 RSV)

It should be the most perfect and appropriate scripture, I thought.

However, the scripture given to me today was from the book of John. I believe it was also given to *Kohitsuji no Mure*.

For God so loved the world that he gave his only son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.
(John 3:16 RSV)

I did receive the same scripture soon after the *White Dove*. One morning I heard the Lord say to me, "Read the Bible," and in surprise I asked Him, "Where in the Bible should I read?" Then I heard the *voice*, "John." When I asked, "Where in John?" the numbers "3 · 1 · 6" appeared in my eyes. It took me more than half a year to realize that it was John 3:16. God spoke to us in various ways, and I learned that He would convey His wishes through the scriptures in the Bible.

God sent His Son Jesus Christ to us. He so loved the world that He gave us the life of His only Son. We did not welcome Him, but rejected, persecuted and actually killed Him. However, God gave up His Son's life for us, because He wanted every one of us to have eternal life without perishing. Jesus responded to His Father's will, and showed us the love of God by abandoning His life. I cannot explain the love of God the Father and the love of His Son no matter how much I try to. Absolute is the love of God.

There exists such a thing as the absolute love. All things are derived from this love and return to it. This love is the very desire of God. I believe the *White Dove* was sent to us to convey God's love and His sincere desire to the whole world. The past twenty years were given to us to spread His love all over the earth, and even more so will be the days hereafter.

God sent us the *White Dove*, wishing everyone to know His love and live in His desire. He wants none of us to be left out. "Receive the eternal life" means to know God the Father and His Son Jesus Christ. Know Jesus Christ. The *White Dove* will continue to fly, carrying the will of God on its wings.

And this is eternal life, that they know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom thou hast sent. (John 17: 3 RSV)
